



## **OGHS Booster Meeting Minutes 1/22/24**

**Attendance** – 6

**Financial update** – Current Balance -\$53,834.17

Outstanding invoices for football helmets at \$4028.29 and concession reorders.

Meeting was called to order by Jeff and he confirmed that Amy Freezor and Jessica Lane are officially doing the jobs of split treasurer for the boosters. Concessions for winter sports are doing very well and Shana has been helping with the basketball games. We are working with her under a new agreement for For-profit vendors with a flat set-up fee of \$300. This will be to be re-negotiated for football. Next year, for football season we will lose Hope City Food Truck and we need to discuss how that will affect concessions and Shana. As for now, Kelly will create a concession sign-up schedule for Spring Sports and get back to Stan before the beginning of the season.

Jessie Arnold reviewed apparel and what we might need for the spring season sports. The group decided on baseball hats (some with leather patch), beanie & blankets since the beginning of the spring season is still cold. New storage cabinets have been purchased and are in the process of being built for the apparel. Jessie has new equipment arriving that can do engraving and that may open up more gear or special order merchandise in the future. We will need to review further but would like to have a plan in place for next fall. May want to set up for Meet the Grizzlies this Spring for the 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

Stan announced that we have looked into purchasing Hudl package that would be beneficial to all sports. This would be approximately \$900 for all sports except football (\$1600). Any tools and upgrades to each sports package will be up to that sport to pay. The sports interested in using Hudl right now are: football, volleyball, men's & women's basketball and men's & women's soccer. This will be a great tool for our sports programs.

Stan also advised that we need to keep in mind this summer we will need to aerate & top-dress the football field along with the baseball infield & softball outfield. This should cost us around \$8-9K. Next year's uniform rotation will be Baseball & softball \$3,000 each. The following year will be football and that we cost us \$15,000.

Congratulations to our Swim team our place 2<sup>nd</sup> for the girls and 1<sup>st</sup> for the boys. Wrestling placed 3<sup>rd</sup> with the potential of 6 individuals going to state. Springs sports practices will begin on February 14<sup>th</sup>.
