



**Meeting:** OGHS Athletic Booster Club

Minutes from our July 17, 2017 meeting were distributed to all who were in attendance and approved.

- 1) OGHS apparel was distributed to those that were in attendance. What was left could be picked up at the high school Friday, August 25<sup>th</sup> or during the student tours. The boosters made over \$800.00 in apparel sells. The Fan Gear website is available again and you can elect to have your apparel shipped to your home address. The seat cushions had never been ordered before and are not what we anticipated. Anyone who ordered a cushion will get two due to the size. If customers are not satisfied, we will find a solution.
- 2) Kip provided an update on our treasurer, Judy Vaughn, and once her obligation with Ledford is over, she'll come onboard. We think it may be November but in the interim Steve Kidder will handle all treasury duties.
- 3) Pepsi Credit Application—Kip and Julie to complete application and turn into Pepsi by end of week.
- 4) Bobby Mills provided our concession stand status, particularly regarding football since our first home game is 9/7. Bobby called the health department to setup appointment regarding the concerns they have. They were unable to make the appointment so Eddie Longbottom has setup another one for Wednesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Some of the concerns are that the sink is not up to code & windows have no screens. Also, the size of the football concession stand is a concern. They will not issue a permit until the items are fixed. . Plan B would be to setup tables outside and sell packaged items. Kip also suggested renting a food truck/trailer in order to sell hot dogs, nachos, etc.
- 5) Parking Lot/Press Box update: Construction company will maintain far side of parking lot until construction is complete. Score boards are stored at the school and Stan is hopeful that they'll release them the week before Labor Day and our maintenance dept. can install them.
- 6) Regarding gate fees. JV players can get into a varsity game of the same sport for free. School aged and above will be expected to pay regular admission.



- 7) Eddie Longbottom participated in the Wallburg Referral Club that dismantled itself and there was a \$2000.00 balance. The club decided to donate to our OGHS Booster Club.
- 8) As our first big fundraiser, we plan to have 'Casino Night' sometime in late October or November. Bobby is looking into renting Richard Childress's banquet hall in Welcome. Booster members need ask for donations/prizes from local businesses in preparation for it.
